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## Treasurer's Report

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Our August budget report reads as follows: Our Income was a total of \$5,145.87, of which \$505.00 was through the Capital Campaign, \$640.87 was through miscellaneous fundraising (including the camper raffle), and the other \$4000.00 was from the Cat Shack.

We did make purchases of \$300.86 in food for the Freshman Transition Camp, \$250.86 on the 2016-2017 PTSA Calendar Cards, \$50.00 in a bank fee, \$3574.00 in new computers for the Yearbook, and \$3243.33 in new merchandise for the Cat Shack.

Capital Campaign will be in full swing soon!

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## Committees

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Freshman Transition Camp- (Sarah Green)- While this was not as successful as it has been in previous years, there was still a great turnout for this event.. Next year, it was suggested that we include the information about Cat Shack and Pizza in the What to Bring Flyer starting in the spring. It was also mentioned that we needed to have representation in more of the planning portion of this event starting earlier next year and getting volunteers in May/June for this August Event!

The Hospitality Committee has already gotten out the Welcome Back Bags to all of the teachers, Some of the other things that they will be handling this year includes 2 luncheons, Wellness Bags, and Guidance Week items. Be on the lookout for Sign up Genius Links to come out in the future.
